















### Women's Coalition of St. Croix Mission Statement :

  - Community training and education to public and private sectors




### Our Program has extensions for service to include:

# WHERE ARE WE? Our location also means that access to services is very limited as being an island, the option to flee an abuser would be solely by plane or by boat. Being a US Territory, we are easily accessible, and many times used as a place to escape by mainland abusers. - During the Take Back the Night Event, we present the "Shoe Project" where we call the names of all known victims, who have lost their lives due to Domestic Violence.
- We invite someone from the community to speak or do a presentation that focuses on Domestic Violence.



- Annually we have a "She/Hero Award that is given to people in the community who has done something outstanding in assisting victims/survivors of Domestic Violence.
- At the end of each TBTN Event we do a "Community Count Down", so that we know how many people have attended.
